

Making Nouns Plural

Most Regular Nouns

Add **-s**

one lover => many lovers
one blowjob => many blowjobs
one tongue => many tongues
one dick => many dicks

Nouns Ending in O

Rule 1

Add **-s**

one photo => many photos
one video => many videos
one porno => many pornos
one tattoo => many tattoos

Nouns Ending in O

Rule 3

Add **-s** or **-es**

one tornado => many tornados
or tornadoes
one mosquito => many
mosquitos or mosquitoes
one dildo => many dildos
or dildoes

Nouns Ending in S, SH, CH, X or Z

Add **-es**

one ass => many asses
one bitch => many bitches
one wish => many wishes
one buzz => many buzzes
one bikini wax => many waxes

Nouns Ending in O

Rule 2

Add **-es**

Write on a Post-it.
The rest can end in -s.

one tomato => many tomatoes
one potato => many potatoes
one volcano => two volcanoes
one hero => many heroes
one echo => many echoes
one torpedo => two torpedoes
one veto => many vetoes
one embargo => two embargoes

Wait.
What's a Vowel?

Vowels: a, e, i, o, u
 (sometimes **y** and **x** once in a while)

Consonants: everything else

**Nouns Ending in
 vowel + Y**
Add -es

one toy => many toys
 one donkey => many donkeys
 one valley => many valleys
 one Friday => many Fridays

**Common Nouns Ending in
 a Consonant + Y**
Change the Y to I and add -es

one orgy => many orgies
 one pussy => many pussies
 one puppy => many puppies
 one party => many parties

Irregular Nouns

one man => many men
 one woman => many women
 one person => many people
 one child => many children
 one goose => many geese
 one mouse => many mice
 one tooth => many teeth
 one foot => many feet
 one die => many dice
 one ox => many oxen

**Proper Nouns Ending in
 a Consonant + Y**
Add -s

one Kennedy => many Kennedys
 one Brandy => many Brandys (name)
 (one brandy => many brandies-liquor)
 one July => many Julys
 one January => many Januarys

Nouns that Don't Change

one moose => many moose
one fish => many fish
one series => many series
one deer => many deer
one sheep => many sheep
one species => many species
one buffalo => many buffalo
one shrimp => many shrimp

Nouns Derived from Latin & Greek Ending in ON or UM Change ON or UM to -a

one phenomenon => two phenomena
one criterion => many criteria
one datum => many data
one rectum => many recta or rectums
one medium => many media

Acronyms & Abbreviations Add -s. No apostrophe.

one PDF => many PDFs one STI => many STIs
one DVD => many DVDs one BBC => many BBCs
one BBW => two BBWs

Nouns Derived from Latin & Greek Ending in US Change US to -i

one focus => many foci
one cactus => many cacti
one radius => many radii (RAY-dee-i) or radi-uses
one fungus => many fungi
one nucleus => many nuclei
one alumnus => many alumni (males or mixed group)
one alumna => many alumnae (females only)
hippopotamus => hippopotami or hippopotamuses (It's easier to spell *hippos*, though.)
one octopus => two octopuses or octopi (It's from Greek, not Latin, so it would be *octopedes*. We don't use it in English though.)

Nouns Derived from Latin & Greek Ending in IS Change IS to -es

one axis => many axes
one crisis => many crises
one analysis => two analyses
one thesis => 95 theses
one penis => many penes or penises
one index => two indices or indexes
one appendix => two appendices or appendixes
